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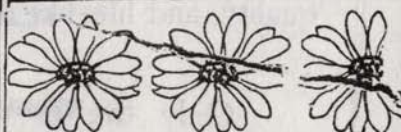


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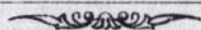

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FOREWORD.

IT is becoming more generally recognised that the system adopted by many Gramophone Companies of compelling Artistes to sing under contract at fixed times (without consideration as to the Artistes convenience or health), is pernicious to best results, as it tends, by its machine-like commercialism to lower the Singers artistic virility, and the consequent result is merely a mechanical reproduction, in no way representative of the capacity of the Artistes, and in many instances entirely devoid of colour and life.

This is proved by the poor results attained by many Gramophone Recording Companies who have recorded some of the most eminent Artistes of the day, and yet totally failed to give anything approaching the singers capacity and public reputations.

The Management of the Sound Recording Company, Ltd., is keenly aware that it is necessary to eliminate this phase, and consequently do not engage Artistes under contract.

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Artistes have signified by their courteous letters that they fully appreciate our recognition of the necessary conditions for obtaining a natural reproduction of their voice, and we confidently submit the records classified in this catalogue to the judgment of the Public to endorse our claim for the production of Superb Records.
